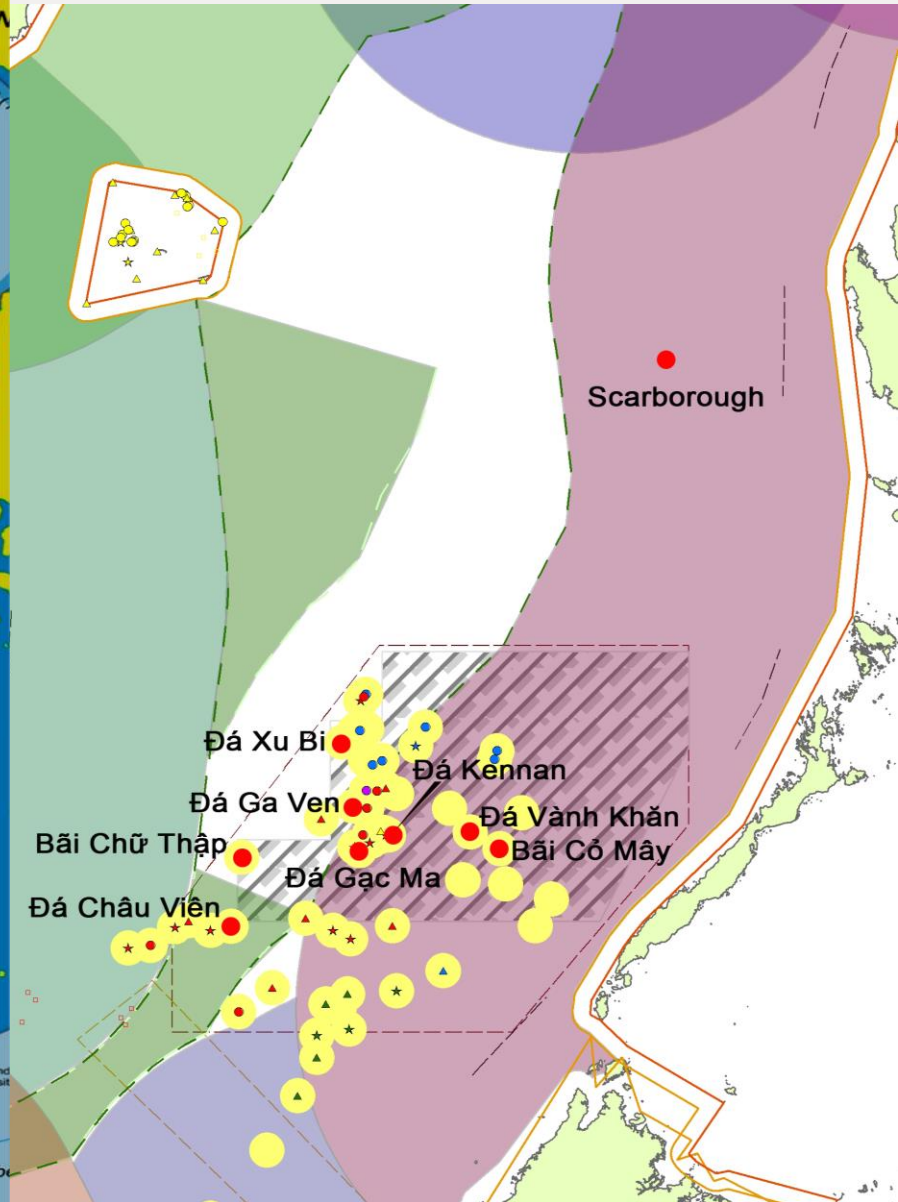
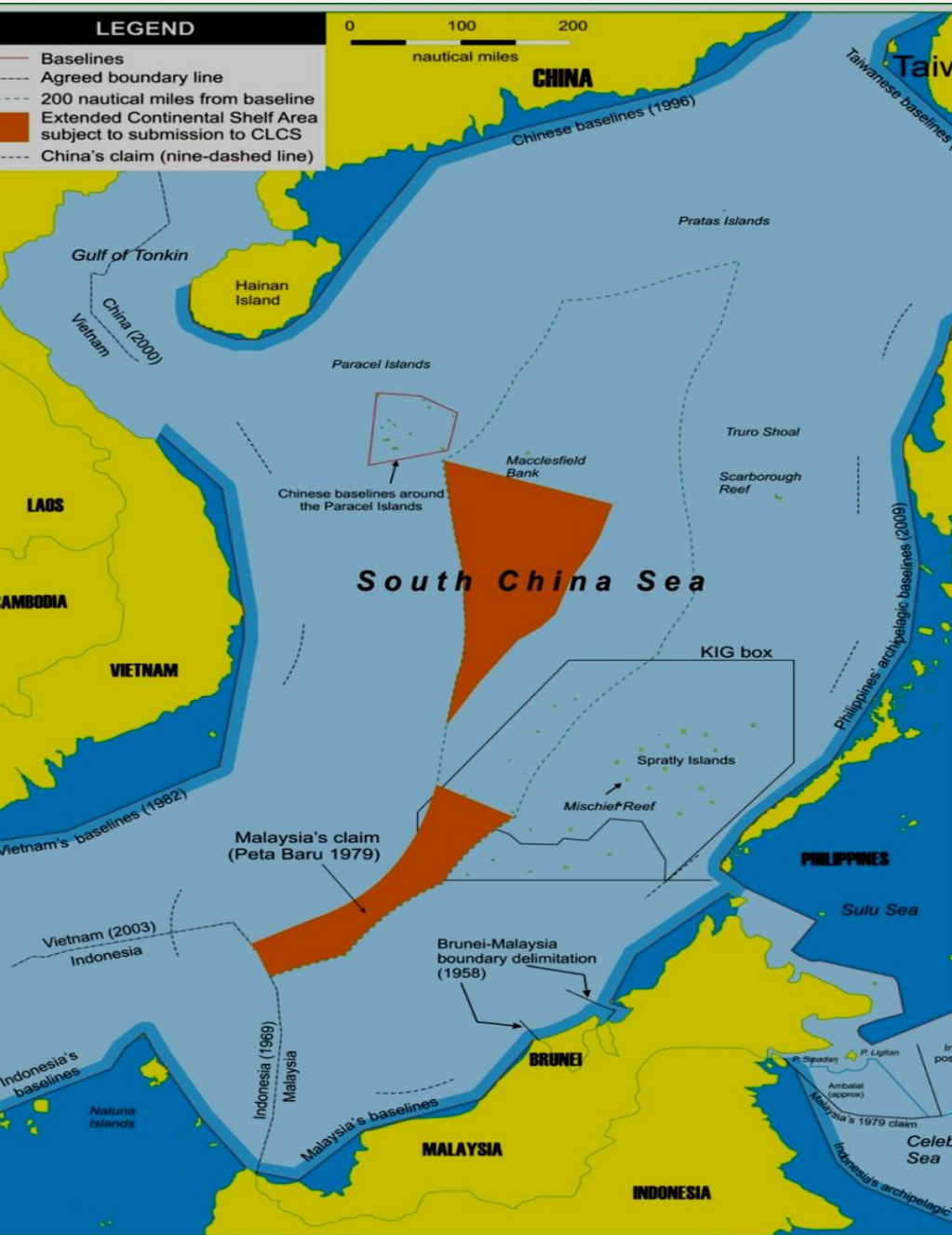

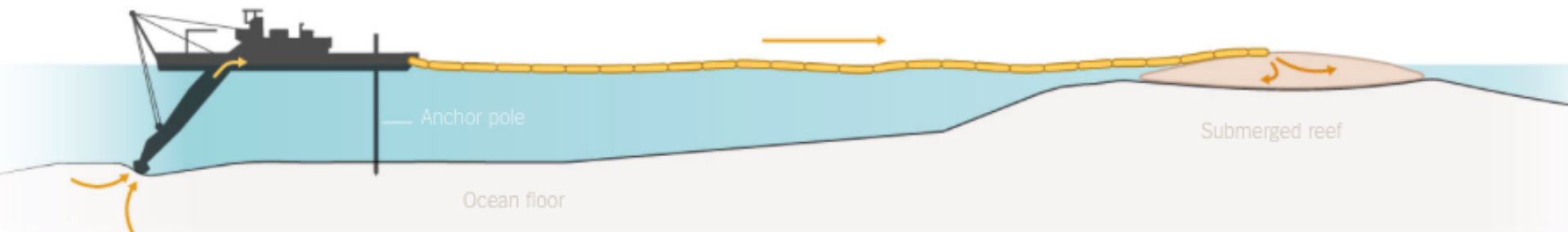
Uphold international law

CASE STUDY 1: NEA US – VIETNAM 28/9-4/10/2016

- Guided-missile destroyer USS John S McCain (DDG 56), Personnel from CTF 73, DESRON 7, and 7th Fleet Rock Band "Orient Express"
 - Expert discussion: navigation, shipboard medicine, damage control
 - Symposia in military medicine and maritime law
 - Sea phase: Practice CUES and SAR scenario
 - Community service events: multiple performances by Rock Band "Orient Express"
 - USS John S. McCain and the Emory S. Land-class submarine tender USS Frank Cable: 2- day port visit in Cam Ranh

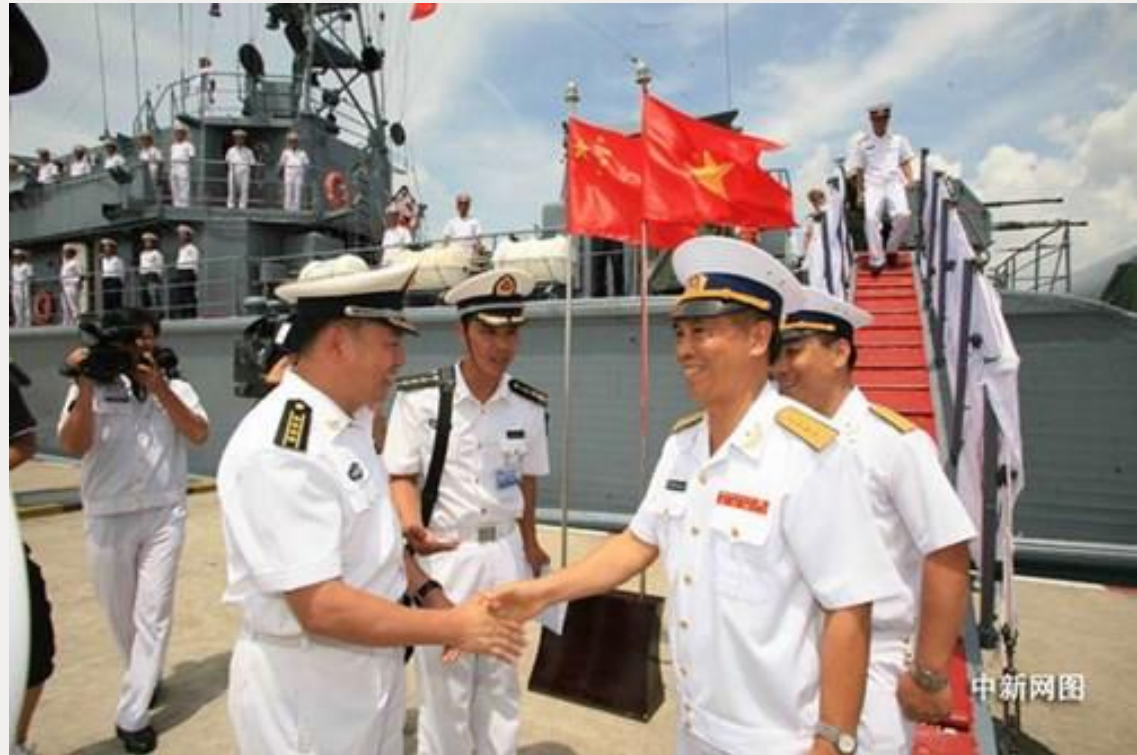
CASE STUDY 2: JAPAN – VIETNAM 4/2016

- Two maritime Self-Defense Force destroyers Ariake and JS Setogiri, carrying 500 crew members of the Japan Maritime Self-Defense Force docked at Cam Ranh International Seaport
 - Sharpening the skills and exchange activities between Japanese and Vietnamese naval officers
 - Training session with their Vietnamese counterparts on CUES

CASE STUDY 3: CHINA-VIETNAM

- Joint fishing in the Gulf of Tonkin: Joint patrol between two navies and coast guards (2005-)
- Port visits, joint partrol, joint exercise on SAR, radio and visual signaling between two navies
